

## Spain, Madrid, La Zarzuela racecourse (2001 / 2004)


In 2004, Technical assistance for the renovation of the tracks and building for the re-opening of the racecourse

## Greece, Athens (2002-2003)

Technical and economic feasibility study of a project concerning the development of a prestige site dedicated to the horse and including national and international sport events, training and promotion of the local breeding activity







## France, Domaine du Haras de Jardy
